## DEFINE

Describing the problem as it is currently understood.

- Five Why's
- "How might we" Questions
- Challenge Brief
- Stakeholder Analysis

## RESEARCH

Doing the homework on the problem space, context and potential solution spaces.

- Empathy Map
- Asking Questions
- Interpret

## IDEATE

Generating possibilities.

- Ideation

## PROTOTYPE

Making something in order to make it better.

- Sketch
- Build

## TEST

Soliciting people's feedback in order to improve or validate what we've discovered or designed.

- Watch and Learn
- Feedback Grid

## DECIDE

Choosing directions, setting priorities, and reaching consensus in a group.

- Dot Vote
- Cluster
- \$100 Test
- Impact/Effort Matrix
